## League Financial Management Training Class

While local Little Leagues are run by volunteers, they are also small businesses handling significant amounts of cash and dealing with multiple vendors. Even the best run leagues face challenges as board positions change from year-to-year. Clear, accurate records and accounting are essential in avoiding problems and ensuring efficient operations. Dealing with such issues requires a good understanding of basic accounting. Federal and State reporting requirements and transparency in operations are critical.

Because developing sound financial management structures within a league strengthens its operations and enhances the ability to provide quality programs for the boys and girls in Little League. FOSER, in co-sponsorship with the Florida Little League DA Association has worked with Little League International to develop a financial management program tailored to the specific needs of Florida's leagues.

This one day program is designed to particularly aid league presidents and treasurers, as well as other board members responsible for the finacial activities of the league. You will learn how to strengthen financial skills and develop practices that benefit your league, and establish a sound basis for future years. Highly skilled presenters will provide you with information to make your jobs easier and provide the opportunity to discuss issues of specific concerns to your leagues.

Presenters for this event will be *Dave Houseknecht, CFO of Little League International, and Richard Waler Jr., a Florida CPA* with extensive experience with Little League organizations.
