## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. There will be a mandatory Team Manager Meeting on 7/7/23 at 1:00PM. At this meeting we will go over tournament format, schedule, and rules. If you have ANY questions about this tournament PLEASE ask them at this meeting.
2. Team affidavits and all supporting documents will be reviewed before game time.
3. DIAMOND LEADER and CONCUSSION certification MUST be in team book. EACH MANAGER must have proof of Diamond Leader, manager and coach(es) must have Concussion.
3. Games will be played in accordance with Tournament Rules located in the back of the Little League Rule Book.
4. Umpires will check all equipment prior to EACH game. Faulty/illegal equipment will be removed and held until the end of the tournament, or your team is eliminated.
5. Coin flip to determine home/away for all initial games will be at the tournament briefing meeting. Home team will occupy 1<sup>st</sup> base dugout. You will turn in a copy of your lineup (4 carbon copy) to the official scorekeeper 15 mins prior to start of game. If there are any delays or issues they will be communicated at this time.
6. Pitching Affidavits will be filled out completely following each game. Each manager is responsible to assure his/her Pitching Affidavit is accurate prior to leaving the game site. The Pitching Affidavit is the official record of pitching and will not be changed after one hour of the end of the game.
7. Teams should arrive at least one (1) hour prior to scheduled game start time to ensure time to warm up.
8. No hitting balls against the fences.
9. Teams must pick up all trash in their dugout before vacating at the end of the game, spectators should clean up their areas as well.
10. NO COOLERS or outside food are allowed inside the complex (exception being team coolers for drinks/towels in the dugout).

11. The use of tobacco (all forms) and alcohol is strictly prohibited inside the complex. Smoking areas will be designated.
12. Dogs are **NOT** allowed in the complex.
13. Obscene language, gestures, and harassment by **ANYONE** will NOT be tolerated. Offenders will be asked to promptly leave the complex.
14. NO music/sound machines or noise makers. **NO WALK-UP MUSIC IS PERMITTED.**
15. If the game is stopped for lightning, we ask that parents take their kids to their cars.
16. In the event of a delay due to weather, an expected resume window will be given. If it will be an extended delay and your players choose to leave the game site it will be your responsibility to have your players return and ready to play within 30 minute notice.

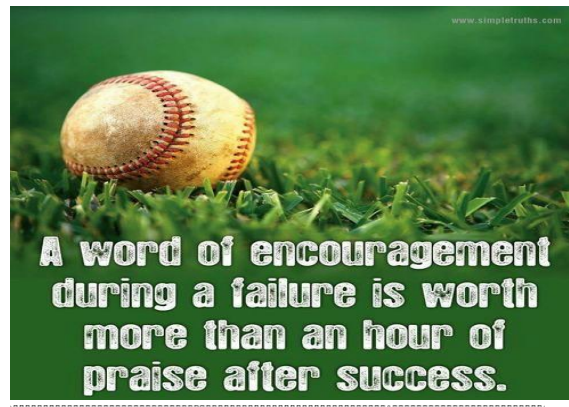

# Staying Safe from Lightning at the Field

Lightning poses a serious threat during the Little League® regular and tournament seasons. In the United States, lightning activity picks up during the spring and peaks during the summer. Having a plan and knowing what to do when lightning approaches is important for player and fan safety.

This starts with being "weather aware" by staying on top of the latest forecast from a trusted, local meteorologist. A quiet summer day can turn stormy very quickly, so it's important to be ready for quickly changing weather. We use a smartphone app at the field to monitor rain and thunderstorms approaching the area.

Lightning can strike long before it starts raining! In fact, many lightning strike victims are hit before rain begins. Lightning can strike over 10 miles away from a thunderstorm, so action may need to be taken before the wet weather arrives.

If we hear thunder or observe threatening skies, we will be monitoring the situation! It is not safe to be outside when lightning is in your area. Dugouts and pavilions do not provide safe cover during thunderstorms, and never seek shelter under a picnic shelter, under bleachers, or in a shed.

When lightning threatens, seek safety in a sturdy building that has plumbing and electricity. If this isn't an option, seek shelter in a hard-topped vehicle with the windows up. While in the vehicle, don't touch anything metal, or any electronics.

It is safe to head back to the field a minimum of 30 minutes after the thunder and lightning have left the area. We will communicate with team managers in the event of a weather delay.
